MARIAN MCFADDEN, A FORMER MAJOR HOSPITAL FOUNDATION BOARD MEMBER, EMBRACED THIS MISSION. SHE UNDERSTOOD THAT IN ORDER TO PROVIDE SUPERIOR HEALTH CARE SOLUTIONS AND OPTIMAL CLINICAL OUTCOMES, THE HOSPITAL MUST HAVE A STREAM OF INCOME TO HELP PURCHASE THE BEST EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE AND TO KEEP THE FACILITY IN TOP-NOTCH CONDITION.

TO THIS END, SHE MADE A \$322,000 GIFT IN HER ESTATE TO THE MAJOR HOSPITAL FOUNDATION. SHE SPECIFIED THAT THE INCOME BE USED FOR “WORTHY IMPROVEMENTS” TO MAJOR HOSPITAL. SINCE HER MOMENTOUS GIFT IN 1975, MANY PIECES OF VITAL EQUIPMENT HAVE BEEN PURCHASED WITH THE TRUST INCOME. SHE WOULD BE PLEASED TO KNOW THAT OTHERS HAVE THE SAME VISION THAT SHE DID AND WOULD WELCOME THEIR FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE MARIAN MCFADDEN TRUST.

Permanent Gifts for State of the Art Patient Care

Your gift of \$1,000 or more will be added to the principal of the Marian McFadden Trust, and the income will be used to help fund equipment, technology and/or hospital building projects—all of which are necessary to provide state-of-of-the-art patient care.

The Major Hospital Foundation’s investment policy is designed for conservative growth, so that the trust will grow along with the needs of the community and hospital. Each year, at the discretion of the Foundation’s Board of Directors, 80% of the trust income is used to make equipment/technology/building purchases, and 20% of the income is reinvested in the principal of the trust.



Marian McFadden, 1904-1975

Marian McFadden was a dedicated public servant, both in her professional and personal lives. She was employed at the Shelbyville Public Library and several Indianapolis libraries. She also served as the director of the Indianapolis Public Library and was named the director of State Public Libraries from 1944 until her retirement in 1956. She was a member of the Shelbyville Central Schools board of trustees, recipient of the Shelby County Chamber’s “Citizen of the Year” award in 1974 and was the first recipient of the Rotary Club Arts and Humanities Award. She was author of the book, Biography of a Town: Shelbyville, Indiana, 1822-1962. Her photograph here is courtesy of the Indianapolis Marion County Public Library.
